TRF415MSX & Marc Rheinard Take Victory!



Tamiya Racing Factory (TRF) driver and current World Champion driver Marc Rheinard took victory at the 2006 Reedy Race of Touring Car Champions, held from May 25th to 28th at the Tamiya America R&D Test Facility in Aliso Viejo, California. This event hosted 28 Invitational Class drivers, 100 Open Spec. drivers and 70 Modified Class drivers, for one of the major R/C racing events of the year.

The tournament saw lots of thrillingly close finishes, particularly in the 3rd Round, where Marc dropped into 5th place following a mistake, only to recover the top spot in the final two laps. With 6 out of 8 races counting, Marc took 1st place in 5 races, and 2nd place in 1 race. These results gave him a one point lead over rival Atsushi Hara, who came in 2nd overall. In addition to Marc's 1st place victory, two other Tamiya drivers, Josh Numan and Hupo Hoenigl, were among the top 4 finishers, which are results that we are truly proud of.
